2019 Registration and Training Timeline

TBD: Registration deadline.

Registration taken on a first come, first serve basis.

TBD: Tuition payment is due in full to CCFH.

Full cost of training is \$850 per trainee. This includes both the morning CARE Training and afternoon Facilitator Training. If a registrant has attended a CARE Training since January 2015, a reduced fee will be offered. Additional instructions will be provided to accepted trainees.

TBD: In-person CARE Training —9 am-12:30 pm in Durham, NC.

TBD: In-person CARE Facilitator Training —1 pm-5 pm in Durham, NC.

TBD: Facilitate a CARE Training; attend four consultation calls.

Requirements

To become a CARE facilitator participants must:

- Have completed training in at least one of the following evidence-based models:
 - Helping the Non-Compliant Child (HNC)
 - Incredible Years (IY)
 - Parent-Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT)
 - Parent Management Training -Oregon Model (PMTO)
- Participate in a half-day CARE training
- Participate in a half-day CARE facilitator training
- Participate in consultation calls following CARE facilitator training
- Facilitate at least 1 CARE training within 1 year of facilitator training
